Rules & Regulations to be Followed

1. Fee for an academic year is calculated from the normal date of re-opening of the college, that is the 1st June to the normal date of closing, that is 31st of March, irrespective of the date of admission of the student.
2. Fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstance.
3. Normally the entire fee for the academic year should be paid at the time of admission. Those who pay in two installments will have to pay the fine due thereof and SSLC Book also to be submitted.
4. SC/ST/OEC Students are eligible for Government grant.
5. Every student shall attend classes including / online classes punctually.
6. The working day is divided into two sessions and each session into four periods of one hour. (Subject to change in the case of online classes)
7. The first bell is rung five minutes before the commencement of each session and the second bell at the hour fixed for the beginning of the class.
8. At the first bell before each session, students should move towards their respective classes and take their seats before the second bell so as to be present when the lecturer enters the class at the third bell. All students shall stand up in silent prayer at the fourth bell after which the classes commence work.
9. Every student should respectfully greet the teachers on meeting them for the first time in the college everyday.
10. On the Lecturers entering the classroom the students shall rise and remain standing till the Lecturers have taken seat.
11. During the absence of the lecturer as well as in moving from one class to another care should be taken to observe silence.
12. No student shall use tobacco or any intoxicant in any form in the college, and in the college premises.
13. Students are forbidden to write or make any marks on the walls of the college building or furniture or throw paper or ink on the floor of the classroom.
14. All serious damages done to college property will be strictly penalised.
15. After commencement of the lecture, no student is allowed to enter or go out of the classroom without the prior permission of the teacher in-charge.
16. Irregular attendance, in subordination to teachers, habitual inattention to class works, obscenity in word or deed are sufficient reasons for the permanent or temporary dismissal of the student.
17. The students are strictly forbidden to engage in any political or other movement.
18. Students shall switch off mobile phones during college time and should not misuse it.
